# PLANNING FOR HIGH SCHOOL - PAUL KANE HIGH SCHOOL

## INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

### I. HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA

The Alberta High School Diploma is awarded to students who meet the requirements outlined below.

To earn an Alberta High School diploma, a student must:

- Earn a minimum of 100 credits
- Complete and meet the standards of the following courses:
  - English 30-1 or 30-2
  - Social Studies 30-1 or 30-2
  - Mathematics 20 Pure, Mathematics 20 Applied or Mathematics 24
  - Science 20 or 24 or Biology 20 or Chemistry 20 or Physics 20
- Complete and meet the standards of the following:
  - Physical Education 10 (3 credits)
  - Career and Life Management (CALM) 20 (3 credits)
  - 10 credits from Career and Technology Studies (CTS) or Fine Arts or Second Languages or Phys. Ed. 20 and Phys. Ed. 30
  - 10 credits in any 30-level courses (including locally developed courses) in addition to English 30-1 or 30-2 and Social Studies 30-1 or 30-2.

### II. PURPOSES OF DIFFERENT COURSE SERIES

In four subject areas- English Language Arts, Social Studies, Mathematics and Science - there are different course series that are developed for a variety of purposes and have varying degrees of difficulty. The different course series are numbered accordingly.

- Course series numbered 10-2, 20-2, 30-2 (in Social Studies and in English Language Arts) or named Applied (e.g. Applied Math 10) are designed primarily for students planning entry into certain programs in colleges and technical schools, trade schools, or entry into employment.
- Math 30 Applied is accepted for entrance into some University programs. Please consult applicable University calendar for detailed prerequisites
- Course series numbered 10-1, 20-1, 30-1 (in Social Studies and in English Language Arts) or named Pure (e.g. Pure Math 10) are designed primarily for students planning entry into university or certain programs in colleges and technical schools.
- Course series numbered 14-24 are designed primarily for students planning direct career entry into some areas of employment.

### III. ENTRANCE TO POST-SECONDARY INSTITUTIONS

An Alberta High School Diploma does not ensure a student's admission into post-secondary institutions. Before selecting their high school courses, students should consult their school counsellor. Admission requirements for these institutions vary as they are set by the individual institutions and the faculties and departments within these institutions.
