PLANNING FOR HIGH SCHOOL

HOW TO SELECT YOUR GRADE 10 COURSES

STEP 1 100 credits are required to earn an Alberta High School Diploma. Grade 10 students should not have any spare periods: they will need to register in a program with at least 40 "in class" credits.

STEP 2 Choose one class from each of English, Math, Science and Social Studies.

◆ French Immersion students must choose **FLA 10** plus at least two other core courses where French is the language of instruction.
