Strategies:

- What specific steps will you take to meet your goals?

Stage One: Allow English teachers to organically discover methods of integrating Kurzweil 3000 into their classroom.

Stage Two: Create student accounts for all students.

Stage Three: Install pronunciation dictionary and other languages

Stage Four: Encourage students to use it for proof-reading essays during in-class essay periods.

Stage Five: Scan novels and other readings into PDF files and have them converted into KESI files and stored onto Student Shared Files for easy student access.

Stage Six: Create PKSub folders for substitute teachers so they can access digital files, like KESI files.

Stage Seven: Have students use Kurzweil 3000 to read a chapter or two from the novel during class time.

Stage Eight: Purchase 2 mobile Memory Sticks for student use at home.

Stage Nine: Show students how to find homophones and confusables on Kurzweil 3000.

Stage Ten: Help other teachers from other subject areas to use Kurzweil 3000, as requested.

Stage Eleven: Bring Kurzweil 3000 into the classroom by installing it on the other two stand alone computers that have been requested for English classrooms. Have students profile its use in group activities and presentations. The software could read and track the quotes out loud during a presentation.

Stage Twelve: Bring Kurzweil 3000 into the classroom by installing it on a class set of laptops for 1:1 wireless mobility.
